9-Hole Students:

Ages 12 to 17. This age group will have 1 hour of full swing, short game and on course instruction every week starting at 8 am. After the hour of instruction the students may play 9 holes to complete their day of Junior Golf. Play should finish between 11:15-11:45

6-Hole Students:

Ages 8 to 11. This age group will have 1 hour of full swing, short game and on course instruction every week starting at 9:15 am. After the 1 hour of instruction the students may play 6 holes to complete their day of Junior Golf. Play should finish between 11:45-12:15 for 6 hole players.

Beginner Students:

Ages 5 to 7. This age group will have 30 minutes of full swing, short game and on course instruction every week starting at 10:30 am. After the 30 minutes of instruction the students will play 1-3 holes to complete their day of Junior Golf. Play should finish between 12:00-12:15 for these players.
